Sale Procedure

Heifers will be sold in uniform lots sorted according to breed type, size and calving dates. Heifers become the property of the purchaser immediately after sale and become purchaser's risk as soon as sold. No cattle will be loaded until the conclusion of the sale and all fees will be collected by Southeast Mississippi Livestock AAL. Loading assistance will be provided.

December 12, 2019, revaccinated and wormed with Eprinex pour on, pregnancy tested and pelvic measured. Hieifer's #71-80 sires are registered Braford Bulls, Dams are mostly Braford/Gelbvieh/Angus black cattle, Heifers #81-95 sires are registered Balancer (Gelbvieh/Angus) bulls, Dams are Braford, Gelbvieh/Angus Cross cattle. All heifers will be 26-28 months old.
